- How were relationships affected by the fall? What do you notice from the text as the direct effect?
  - How were Adam and Eve's relationships with God, one another, and even self affected?
- How does shame affect relationships in the text both before and after the fall?
- What hope do we have in Jesus for restored relationships?
- What is Jesus' relational vision for Calvary Church? How can we pursue this vision as broken people?

- Currently, do you experience more loneliness in your relationships with others, God, or self?
- How have you intentionally cultivated relationships with God, others, and self?
- How might you intentionally cultivate deeper relationships in each relational category?
- What fears make being truly known in our church community challenging?
- What can you remember about Jesus and his vision for the church when you are wrestling with those thoughts and feelings?
